SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEES

Upon consideration of the "Petition for Release of Certain Attorneys' Fees" filed herein on March 4, 1968, by the petitioners, Ralph W. Disney, executor of the last will and testament of Wesley E. Disney, deceased, and Ida J. Rogers, executrix of the last will and testament of Charles B. Rogers, deceased, asking for an allowance of the balance of the attorneys' fees, earned in this case, to wit, the sum of \$56,953.56, the disposition of which has been held in abeyance pending further order of the Commission; and, in consideration of the Commission's findings of fact and opinion entered herein on March 18, 1965, the Commission's supplemental opinion of April 23, 1965, and the Commission's supplemental findings of fact this day entered, all of which matters are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes that the petitioners are entitled to the balance of the attorneys' fees as requested in their petition.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that from the attorneys' fees of \$162,724.46 awarded under previous order of the Commission, there shall be awarded to the petitioners herein, Ralph W. Disney, executor of the last will and testament of Wesley E. Disney, deceased, and Ida J. Rogers, the executrix of the last will and testament of Charles B. Rogers, deceased, the balance thereof, or the sum of \$56,953.56.
