FINAL JUDGMENT

On May 31, 1968 the petitioner herein and the defendant filed a joint motion, entitled "Joint Motion for Consolidation and Entry of Final Judgment," asking the Commission for an order consolidating the above dockets and approving a compromise settlement of all claims asserted therein, based upon a stipulation entitled, "Stipulation For Entry of Final Judgment," previously filed herein on May 21, 1968.


A hearing on the aforesaid stipulation for entry of final judgment was held on May 21, 1968 and evidence was received in support thereof.


The Commission, having this day entered its findings of fact, 63 through 70, and opinion, which findings of fact and opinion are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed compromise settlement of all Hualapai claims in the above dockets is both just and fair to the petitioner and to the defendant, and, that there is no reason to postpone further the entry of final judgment in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid stipulation for settlement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, the "Stipulation For Entry of Final Judgment" entered into by the parties is hereby approved; the joint motion for the consolidation of the above dockets and for the entry of final judgment pursuant to the terms of said stipulation is granted; and,

the petitioner shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$2,950,000.


