SECOND INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 through 25, the opinion and interlocutory order entered herein on May 8, 1964, and the additional findings of fact numbered 26 through 38 and the concurrent opinion this day entered herein; all of which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that:


1. The Seminole Indians as that tribe was constituted in 1823 and 1832 had aboriginal title to all of Florida, including Keys, south and east of The Old Spanish Road as delineated in Findings numbered 27, 28, and 29, and the eastern perimeter of the Pensacola Purchase as delineated in Findings numbered 30, 31, 32, and 33, less the confirmed Spanish land grants within the awarded lands, less the Picolata Purchase, the western and southern boundaries of which are delineated in Findings numbered 34, 35, and 36, and less the Forbes Purchase, the location and extent of which have been agreed upon by the parties.

2. The same Seminole Indians' title to the Seminole Reservation was recognized by the Camp Moultrie Treaty of September 18, 1823, and continued until the Treaty of Payne's Landing on May 9, 1832, which reservation included a triangular segment on the west-north-west corner of about 50,000 acres embracing the Big Hammock area, as delineated in Findings numbered 37 and 38.


It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that these consolidated cases proceed to a determination of the net acreage comprehended by the several boundaries herein established and the fair

market value thereof on the respective relevant dates, saving all other issues for future trial and determination.




