ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES

Upon consideration of the petition for allowance of attorneys' fees for services rendered in the above-entitled matter, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker; Miss Nellie Manoli, Administratrix, C.T.A. of the Estate of George M. Tunison; and Mrs. Jessie M. Chez, Miriam Ray, Paul S. Chez, Richard B. Chez, and Fred L. Chez, the heirs and next of kin of Joseph C. Chez, deceased, are entitled to an attorneys' fee of \$1,491,500.00, which sum shall be in full compensation for services rendered the petitioners in the above-entitled matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the sum of \$1,491,500.00 there shall be deducted and credited to the Shoshone Tribe of the Wind River Reservation, Wyoming, the sum of \$4,918.21 for payments made under a contract with Mr. George M. Tunison by that Tribe, leaving a net amount of \$1,486,581.79.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that, in accordance with authorization of the above described parties, the net amount of \$1,486,581.79 is to be paid to Robert W. Barker for distribution of the amounts due each of the participating attorneys.
