


ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEES


Upon consideration of the "Petition for Award of Attorney Fees and Affidavit and Exhibits in Support Thereof," filed herein on May 9, 1968, by J. Roy Thompson, Jr. and Frank Miskovsky, attorneys for Petitioners in the above captioned dockets, and the Commission's Findings of Fact this day entered herein, which Findings of Fact are hereby made a part of this Order, the Commission concludes that in view of the valuable legal services that have been rendered to the Kiowa, Comanche and Apache Tribes of Indians in the successful presentation, prosecution and settlement of the claims in the above dockets, attorney fees in the sum of \$600,000, representing ten percent of the final judgment herein of \$6,000,000, made on behalf of the said Indian Tribes, are awarded in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that there shall be awarded as the attorney fees from the final judgment previously entered in these dockets the sum of \$600,000 to J. Roy Thompson, Jr., W. C. Lewis, Jr., Executor of the Estate of W. C. Lewis, and Goldie B. Miskovsky, Administratrix of the Estate of Frank Miskovsky.
