

FINAL JUDGMENT FOR THE SIOUX TRIBE OF THE FORT PECK RESERVATION, MONTANA, INTERVENOR


Upon the joint motion of the Sioux Tribe of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana, an intervenor, and the United States, defendant, requesting the approval of this Commission of the compromise settlement by the parties of the consideration and offsets issues only, the joint motion having been duly presented to the Commission at a hearing held August 23, 1968, for the entry of final judgment in favor of the Sioux Tribe of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana, all pursuant to a stipulation of settlement incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this judgment, and the Commission being fully advised in the premises, concludes and determines that the settlement is fair and just to the said parties; that the joint motion should be granted, the settlement approved and judgment entered herein accordingly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that final judgment be and is hereby entered in favor of the intervenor Sioux Tribe of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana, against the defendant for the sum of \$1,161,354.41, and the Sioux Tribe of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana, shall have and recover said sum from the defendant.
