
FINAL JUDGMENT


Upon the joint motion of the Petitioner and the Defendant, the joint motion having been duly presented to the Commission at a hearing held for the entry of final judgment in favor of Petitioner, all pursuant to a Stipulation For Compromise Settlement And Entry Of Final Judgment incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this judgment, and the Commission being fully advised on the premises thereof, concludes and determines that the settlement is fair and just to the said parties; that the joint motion should be granted, the settlement approved and judgment entered herein accordingly.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that final judgment be and is hereby entered in favor

of the Upper Skagit Tribe of Indians against the Defendant for the sum of \$385,471.42, and the said Tribe shall have and recover said sum from the Defendant.
