ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY'S REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

HAVING CONSIDERED the application for allowance of unreimbursed attorney expenses and its supporting papers filed herein by Ely M. Aaron, Esquire, attorney of record for the above-named Indian plaintiff, on September 7, 1967, the response thereto filed by the defendant on October 12, 1967, the additional documentary evidence of payment of the claimed expenses supplied by Mr. Aaron on January 22, 1968, Mr. Aaron's oral request of April 18, 1969 that certain claimed expenses in the aggregate amount of \$1,251.51 be regarded as withdrawn from the said application, the contracts under which Mr. Aaron and his associates in the case served the plaintiff herein, and the remainder of the record herein, the Commission finds that:

The said application as originally filed lists attorney expenses totaling \$27,480.02. After deducting the amounts mentioned above aggregating \$1,251.51, the petition is in the total amount of \$26,228.51. All of the expenses included in such total are reasonable and properly reimbursable out of the award herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that there shall be disbursed out of the award herein to the law firm of Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess of 38 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois, as payment in full of its unreimbursed expenses incurred herein, the sum of \$26,228.51.
