FINAL AWARD

Upon all the findings of fact heretofore filed herein, being those numbered 1 through 24, all of which are hereby made a part of this order, and upon defendant's declaration that all gratuitous offsets allowable against the plaintiffs herein between August 4, 1824, and June 30, 1956, have been determined and allowed in the matter of Iowa Tribe, et al., Docket No. 135 (15 Ind. Cl. Comm. 248, 261, 265) and that it is not probable that sufficient offsets have accumulated since June 30, 1956, to justify a claim for any offsets against the interlocutory award entered herein on February 17, 1969, and, therefore, no offsets are being adjudicated in the subject case, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the plaintiffs are entitled to recover from the defendant the principal sum of \$207,752.15 plus additional damages in the amount of \$1,159,949.75 which have been measured by interest on said principal sum at the rate of 5% per annum, simple interest, from June 16, 1857, until February 16, 1969, plus an additional amount of damages to be measured by simple interest at the rate of 5% per annum on the principal sum of \$207,752.15 from February 16, 1969, to the date of payment of said principal sum.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the plaintiffs shall have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$1,367,701.90 plus an additional amount of damages, measured by simple interest at the rate of 5% per annum on the principal sum of \$207,752.15 from February 16, 1969, to the date of payment of said principal sum.
