
INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 through 16 and the opinion this date entered herein, the Commission concludes that:


1. The Cowlitz Tribe had aboriginal title to the lands described in finding of fact numbered 15.
2. The defendant deprived the Cowlitz Tribe of its aboriginal title as of March 3, 1855, without the payment of any compensation therefor.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case proceed to a determination of the acreage and the fair market value of the lands described in Finding of Fact numbered 15 as of March 3, 1855.




