ORDER TRANSMITTING FINDINGS OF FACT TO THE COURT OF CLAIMS


This matter comes before the Commission at this time on an order entered by the United States Court of Claims on May 15, 1967, remanding this case to the Commission to hear additional evidence, including but not limited to testimony of the signatories to the stipulation in Court of Claims Case No. 46640, and to make and report to the Court of Claims findings of fact on the question as to whether by said stipulation, it was the intention of the parties thereto that the final judgment entered in Court of Claims Case No. 46640 would be res judicata as to the lands involved in this case. Pursuant to the Court of Claims order the Commission has this date entered supplementary findings of fact numbered 21 through 30 and


IT IS ORDERED that the findings of fact made by the Commission pursuant to the order and remand from the Court of Claims are hereby transmitted to the Court of Claims.
