FINAL JUDGMENT

UPON JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT filed by the parties herein on July 9, 1969 pursuant to a Stipulation For Entry of Final Judgment filed with said motion, the Commission considered the evidence presented, both oral and written, at a hearing called for that purpose on July 22, 1969.

THE COMMISSION having this day entered additional findings of fact, hereby made a part of this order, and concluded therefore as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the plaintiff's claim is equitable and just to both parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with the stipulation,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment is hereby approved, that the Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment is hereby granted, and that the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of one million two hundred forty thousand dollars (\$1,240,000.00) subject to terms and provisions set forth in the Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment.
