
IT APPEARING to the Commission that an amendment is proper, it is

ORDERED that the claims arising out of the taking by the defendant on November 7, 1906, without compensation, of the plaintiff's aboriginal title lands, as found by this Commission at 15 Ind. Cl. Comm. 666 (1965), shall remain a part of Docket No. 357, and it is further

ORDERED that the claims arising from the proceedings of the Pueblo Lands Act, 34 Stat. 636, as found by this Commission at 15 Ind. Cl. Comm. 666 (1965) shall be known as Docket No. 357-A and that the Clerk shall file the amended petition submitted by the plaintiff on May 28, 1969 under Docket No. 357-A, and it is further


ORDERED that paragraphs 18 and 21 be, and they are hereby, stricken from the original petition filed on August 11, 1951 and are permitted to be incorporated in the amended petition to be known as Docket No. 357-A and that a copy of this order be placed in the original file of Docket No. 357-A.


