ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY'S REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

HAVING CONSIDERED the application filed on February 13, 1969 by Mr. Marvin J. Sonosky, attorney of record for the intervenor Sioux herein, for reimbursement of expenses totaling \$642.85 incurred by him during the last months of his services herein in carrying out the obligations of his contract with the said intervenor, the supporting documentation of the claimed unreimbursed expenses that accompanied the application, the defendant's response of October 8, 1969 to the application, the contract under which Mr. Sonosky served the intervenor Sioux, and the remainder of the record herein, the Commission finds that:


All of the expenses claimed in Mr. Sonosky's application for reimbursement of expenses are reasonable and properly reimbursable out of the award that was entered herein on August 23, 1968 in favor of the intervenor Sioux Tribe of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana (19 Ind. Cl. Comm. 365).


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the aforementioned award there shall be disbursed to Marvin J. Sonosky of Washington, D. C., the sum of \$642.85 as payment in full of the unreimbursed expenses incurred herein by him in connection with the cause of the said intervenor.
