ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEE

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Application for Allowance of Attorney Fee filed herein on August 1, 1969 by the attorney of record in the above-entitled consolidated cases, Paul M. Niebell, Esquire, and the Commission's findings of fact this day entered herein, which findings of fact are made a part of this order, and the defendant interposing no objection, the Commission concludes that in view of the valuable legal services that have been rendered to the Yakima Tribe of Indians of the State of Washington in the successful presentation and prosecution of the claims in the above consolidated dockets, attorney fees in the sum of \$210,000.00, representing ten percent of the final judgment herein entered in the amount of \$2,100,000.00, made on behalf of the said Indian tribe, are hereby awarded to said Paul M. Niebell in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there shall be awarded as attorney fee to be paid from the final judgment previously entered in these consolidated dockets the sum of \$210,000.00 to Paul M. Niebell, Esquire.
