
ORDER

UPON consideration of plaintiffs' motion filed October 6, 1969 and defendant's response thereto filed November 14, 1969, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that:


The claim for land taken by the Act of April 27, 1904, 33 Stat. 319, and the claims for lands, rights and interests ceded under the Treaty of February 19, 1867, 15 Stat. 505, as amended and ratified, and the agreement dated September 20, 1872, 2 Kappler 1057, as amended and ratified, are encompassed by the Second Claim of the petition originally filed in this claim.


