ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Application for Allowance of Attorney Fee filed herein on August 11, 1969 by the attorney of record in the above-entitled case, Angelo A. Iadarola, Esquire, of the firm of Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker, and the Commission's findings of fact this day entered herein, which findings of fact are made a part of this order, and the defendant interposing no objection, the Commission concludes that in view of the valuable legal services that have been rendered to the Yankton Sioux Tribe in the successful presentation and prosecution of the claims in the above docket, attorneys' fee in the sum of \$125,000, representing ten per cent of the final judgment herein entered in the amount of \$1,250,000, made on behalf of the said Indian tribe, is hereby awarded to Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that there shall be awarded as attorneys' fee to be paid from the final judgment previously entered in this docket the sum of \$125,000 to Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker.
