ORDER DENYING MOTIONS AND GRANTING OTHER RELIEF




IT IS ORDERED that the said Motions and each of them be denied, and


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall plead to the


Petition in each of the said suits, on the merits, on or before the 30th day of January, 1970.
