ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY'S REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

HAVING CONSIDERED the application for allowance of unreimbursed attorney's expenses filed on August 1, 1969, for Thomas J. Downs, as administrator with the will annexed of the estate of Howard D. Moses, deceased, by Louis L. Rochmes, attorney of record for the above named plaintiff, the defendant's response to the application filed on August 28, 1969, the documentation of all of the claimed unreimbursed expenses in the vouchers that accompanied the application and those submitted by Mr. Rochmes for examination on February 4, 1970, the contracts under which the late Howard D. Moses served as an attorney for the said plaintiff, and the remainder of the record herein, the Commission finds that:

The application accounts for unreimbursed expenses totaling \$5,123.77 incurred herein by the late Howard D. Moses in the prosecution of the cause of The Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians of Oklahoma. All of the expenses included in this total are reasonable and properly reimbursable out of the judgment money resulting from the final judgment entered herein on August 27, 1968 (19 Ind. Cl. Comm. 368 et seq.).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the aforementioned judgment money there shall be disbursed to Thomas J. Downs, as administrator with the will annexed of the estate of Howard D. Moses, deceased, the sum of \$5,123.77 as payment in full for the unreimbursed expenses incurred herein by the said Howard D. Moses.
