Upon the Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Conclusions of Law this day entered herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition in Docket No. 18-G be, and the same is, hereby dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the claim in Docket No. 57 proceed to a determination of (1) the acreage of the lands ceded, as described in Article 1 of the Treaty of September 24, 1819 (7 Stat. 203), less the reservations as described in the treaty, (2) the fair market value of the ceded lands as of March 25, 1820; and (3) the consideration given for the cession.
