
ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


- 1) Defendant supplement its accounting report dated June 18, 1969, to include the information sought by the plaintiffs.
- 2) Defendant include in the supplemental report an accounting for all matters originating prior to August 13, 1946, and which have continued past that statutory time bar.
- 3) Both parties file with the Commission supplementary briefs covering the status of the Indian funds involved and the question of payment of interest thereon prior to June 30, 1930.


