UPON CONSIDERATION of the plaintiff's motion filed herein on June 22, 1970, to dismiss this case under authority of a Resolution of the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon adopted on June 15, 1970, and a Resolution of the General Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon adopted on June 16, 1970, which resolutions authorize the attorneys for the plaintiff to apply for the dismissal of this case without prejudice, and a letter dated June 24, 1970, to Mr. Frank E. Nash, the attorney of record for the plaintiffs, from the Acting Associate Commissioner of Indian Affairs expressing concurrence in those resolutions and approval of the request of the plaintiff's attorneys that they be permitted to obtain the dismissal of this case without prejudice,


IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiff's motion be, and the same is hereby, granted and the petition in the above designated docket is hereby dismissed without prejudice.


