FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon the joint motion of the parties filed herein on July 24, 1970, for approval of a compromise settlement in accordance with a stipulation of the parties filed on the same date, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference into and made a part of this judgment; and the Commission having held a hearing on the proposed settlement in Washington, D. C., on August 6, 1970, with evidence both oral and written having been received and considered; and findings of fact and an interlocutory order having been made and entered in this matter on September 3, 1970, finding that the said compromise settlement is fair and just to all the parties and has been duly approved by the authorized representatives of plaintiff and the authorized representative of the Secretary of the Interior, and that a final judgment in conformity with said stipulation be entered upon receipt of a certified copy of an order by the United States Court of Claims dismissing said appeals (Appeal Nos. 9-69, 10-69 and 11-69) pending in that Court and remanding the cases to the Commission; and it appearing that such an order dismissing said appeals was entered by the United States Court of Claims on September 15, 1970, and a true copy filed herein, therefore, a final judgment should be entered in accordance with aforesaid stipulation and findings of fact,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that final judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of the plaintiff, the Osage Nation, against the defendant for the sum of \$13,250,000.00.
