FINAL AWARD

An interlocutory order was entered herein on June 10, 1970 (23 Ind. Cl. Comm. 189, 218), awarding plaintiffs the sum of \$125,209.61, less any allowable gratuitous offsets. Gratuitous offsets allowable against the plaintiffs herein between July 17, 1854, and June 30, 1956, were determined and allowed in Kickapoo Tribe, et al. v. United States, Docket No. 316, 18 Ind. Cl. Comm. 550 (1967). On September 10, 1970, the defendant filed a motion advising that it would not claim any gratuitous offsets against the award in this case but requesting that all offsets subsequent to June 30, 1956, be reserved for use by the defendant against any pending or future claims by the Kickapoo Tribes herein. In view of the foregoing, the Commission concludes that the motion should be granted and a final award entered in this claim.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that defendant's motion be granted and all gratuitous offsets subsequent to June 30, 1956, shall be reserved for use by the defendant against any pending or future claims by the Kickapoo Tribes, plaintiffs herein,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiffs herein do have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$125,209.61, in full satisfaction of the claim in Docket No. 316-A.
