Upon the Findings of Fact 1 through 52 inclusive, previously entered herein, Findings of Fact 1 through 14 previously entered in the decision resolving common issues of various Point Elliott Treaty claims, including the instant Docket No. 132, reported as Upper Skagit Tribe of Indians, et al., v. United States, 13 Ind. Cl. Comm. 583 (1964), and Findings of Fact 53 through 60 and the Conclusions of Law, this day filed herein, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the plaintiff is entitled to recover from the defendant the sum of \$42,170.49.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Suquamish Tribe of Indians recover from the United States of America the sum of \$42,170.49.


