ORDER DENYING MOTIONS FOR REHEARINGAND MODIFICATION OF ORDER


On September 25, 1970, the plaintiffs in Docket No. 74 filed a motion for rehearing and for modification of the Commission's interlocutory order, entered in consolidated Docket Nos. 74, 221-A, 350-B, and 350-C, on August 26, 1970. On October 7, 1970, plaintiffs in Docket 74 filed a motion to receive additional exhibits in evidence, and for the modification of the aforementioned interlocutory order. By order of November 4, 1970, the Commission consolidated Docket Nos. 74 and 332-C for the purpose of resolving the issues presented in the motions of plaintiffs in Docket No. 74. On November 12, 1970, plaintiff in Docket No. 332-C filed an objection to the aforementioned motions, and on November 18, 1970, Docket No. 74 plaintiffs filed a response to this opposition.

For the reasons stated in the opinion accompanying this order, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. Docket No. 74 plaintiffs' "Motion for Rehearing," filed September 25, 1970, is denied.
