ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY'S FEES

UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of Marvin J. Sonosky, Esquire, for allowance of attorney's fees for services to the Assiniboine Tribes, intervenors, and the response of the defendant, and in accordance with the findings of fact of the Commission filed herewith,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Marvin J. Sonosky is entitled to attorney's fees for services to the Assiniboine Tribes in the sum of \$310,850.64, representing ten percent (10%) of the final award entered in this docket on June 30, 1969, in favor of the Assiniboine Tribes, of which sum the amount of \$6,000, representing an advance retainer, shall be credited to the account of the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of the Fort Peck Indian Reservation, Montana, and the balance of \$304,850.64 shall be disbursed to Marvin J. Sonosky out of the funds appropriated to pay the aforementioned award.
