FINAL AWARD

An interlocutory order was entered herein on December 11, 1970, (24 Ind. Cl. Comm. 179, 195) awarding each of the plaintiffs the sum of \$1,505,250.00 being one-half the fair market value of certain lands (Royce Area 49) which had been ceded to the United States by the Delaware Tribe and the Piankeshaw Tribe. The Commission further ordered that this case proceed for the purpose of determining the amount of consideration paid the respective tribes and the gratuitous offsets, if any, allowable under section 2 of the Indian Claims Commission Act.

On February 23, 1971, the parties filed a Stipulation on Offsets and Final Judgment wherein it was agreed that the United States made gratuitous expenditures for the benefit of the Piankeshaw Tribe or Nation of Indians in the amount of \$1,255.65; that the amount of treaty consideration to be credited against the interlocutory judgment was \$2,700.00; and that these amounts of money should be deducted in computing the final award. The parties further agreed and stipulated that the United States made gratuitous expenditures for the benefit of the Delaware Tribe or Nation of Indians in the amount of \$2,303.89; that the amount of treaty consideration to be credited against the interlocutory judgment was \$5,700.00; and that these amounts of money should be deducted in computing the final award.


The parties have further stipulated that the amounts set forth above constitute all the offsets which may be claimed, except for gratuitous grants of land, if any, which the plaintiffs agree may be claimed without prejudice by the defendant as offsets in other cases still pending.

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties herein be, and the same is hereby, approved and that the plaintiffs shall have and recover from the defendant in full satisfaction of the claims in Docket No. 289, the following amounts:




