
ORDER DISMISSING THE EIGHTH CAUSE OF ACTION

UPON CONSIDERATION of the motion for voluntary dismissal with prejudice of the eighth cause of action in this docket, filed herein for the plaintiff on February 23, 1971; resolutions numbered 3058 and 3083 adopted by the Tribal Council of the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation, Montana, the governing body of the said tribes, on November 5, 1970, and December 18, 1970, respectively, which authorized, among other things, the filing of the motion to dismiss the eighth cause of action herein; and a letter dated February 22, 1971, to the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker, claims counsel for the said tribes, from the Acting Associate Commissioner of Indian Affairs expressing approval of the aforementioned action of the tribal council and approval of a proposed compromise settlement of a claim in the United States Court of Claims, Docket No. 50233 - Paragraph 7 - General Accounting, which settlement provides for the plaintiff's dismissal with prejudice of the eighth cause of action in this docket,

IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiff's motion be, and the same is hereby, granted and the eighth cause of action in this docket, the last remaining herein, is hereby dismissed with prejudice and Docket No. 156 is hereby closed.


