FINAL AWARD

On February 25, 1971, the plaintiff and the defendant herein filed a joint motion for entry of final judgment and for approval of a proposed compromise settlement of the claims of the plaintiff in the above entitled docket based on a "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment" filed along with said motion. The Commission held a hearing on the motion on March 3, 1971.

The Commission having this day entered its findings of fact and opinion, which findings of fact and opinion are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the said proposed compromise settlement of the claim in the above docket is both equitable and just to the plaintiff and the defendant, and that judgment may be entered in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment" entered into by the parties herein is hereby approved; the joint motion for the entry of final judgment pursuant to said stipulation is hereby granted; and the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$4,500,000 subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment."
