FINAL AWARD

UPON JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT filed by the parties herein on April 5, 1971, pursuant to a Stipulation for Final Judgment filed with said motion, and subsequently modified by an Amended Stipulation for Final Judgment filed April 20, 1971, the Commission considered the evidence presented, both oral and written, at a hearing called for that purpose on April 8, 1971.


THE COMMISSION, having this day entered additional findings of fact, which are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the plaintiff's land claim is equitable and just to both parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with the stipulation as amended.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Stipulation for Final Judgment, as amended, is hereby accepted, that the Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment is hereby granted, and that the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant on its land claim the sum of nine million one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$9,150,000.00) subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the Stipulation for Final Judgment as amended.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon motion heretofore filed by the plaintiff on June 27, 1969, that the plaintiff's accounting claim be


separated from its land claim, and that the plaintiff's accounting claim be designated as Docket No. 22-K before the Commission.
