FINAL AWARD

On April 14, 1971, the plaintiff and the defendant herein filed a "Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment" and for approval of a proposed final compromise settlement of the claim of the plaintiff in the above-entitled docket based upon a "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment" filed along with said motion. The Commission held a hearing on said motion on May 7, 1971.

The Commission having this day entered its findings of fact and opinion, which findings of fact and opinion are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed compromise settlement of the claim in the above docket is both equitable and just to the plaintiff and the defendant, and that judgment may be entered in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the "Stipulation for Entry of a Final Judgment" entered into by the parties is hereby approved; the joint motion for entry of final judgment pursuant to said stipulation is hereby granted; and the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$300,000.00.
