INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the conclusions of law and the opinion this day filed in Docket Nos. 30-A and 48-A, which are hereby made a part of this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stipulation entered into between the parties herein and filed with the Commission on September 4, 1970, is adopted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to the terms of said stipulation, the plaintiffs herein recover from the defendant the sum of \$521,796.00, less any gratuitous offsets which may be subsequently allowed.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this case now proceed to a determination of the gratuitous offsets, if any, which may be allowable under the Indian Claims Commission Act.


