INTERLOCUTORY ORDER


IN CONSIDERATION of the findings of fact numbered 22 through 34 issued this date herein and for the reasons set forth in the concurrent opinion this date entered herein, this Commission concludes as a matter of law that:

1. The plaintiffs' lands west of the Mississippi River in the State of Missouri are bounded by lines beginning at the mouth of the Cuivre River where it joins the Mississippi River; thence westerly in a straight line to a point on the Montgomery-Callaway County line at Section 36, Township 48 North, Range 7 West just west of Mineola, Missouri; thence northerly in a straight line to a point on the Jeffreon River (now the North River) in Shelby County, Missouri, at Section 10, Township 58 North, Range 10 West; thence down the Jeffreon River by its meanders to the Mississippi River; thence down the Mississippi River by its meanders to the point of beginning.
2. The awarded lands enclosed by the boundaries set out immediately above consisted of a gross area of 1,850,000.00 acres.
3. The awarded lands included 109 confirmed foreign land grants aggregating 211,275.61 acres, which parcels are not chargeable against the defendant.
4. The net acreage to be valued amounts to 1,638,724.39 acres.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties shall have thirty days

each in which to conform their proposed findings on value to the boundaries and net acreage herein determined, after which this case shall proceed to a determination of value.
