ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES

UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of the Attorney of Record for the above-named plaintiffs, Rodney J. Edwards, for allowance of attorneys' fees in Docket Nos. 243, 244 and 245, filed herein on November 16, 1970, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith, the Commission concludes that the attorneys for the plaintiff herein are entitled to an attorneys' fee in the amount of \$460,000, for services rendered in the prosecution of plaintiffs' claims in the said dockets, and that the payment to Rodney J. Edwards, Attorney of Record, of the sum of \$460,000 out of the funds appropriated to pay the award herein for distribution by him of the amounts due each of the participating attorneys in accordance with their respective interests therein, will represent payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in this case.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated to pay the final judgment entered herein on September 3, 1970, in favor of the plaintiffs (23 Ind. Cl. Comm. 482), there shall be disbursed to Rodney J. Edwards, Attorney of Record, as payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in connection with the prosecution of this case, the sum of \$460,000 for distribution by him of the amount due

each of the participating attorneys in accordance with their respective interests therein.


