ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES


UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of the Attorney of Record for the above-named plaintiffs, Robert W. Barker, for allowance of attorneys' fees in Docket No. 326-I, filed herein on May 7, 1971, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith, the Commission concludes that the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker is entitled to an attorneys' fee for services rendered in the prosecution of plaintiffs' claim in said docket in the amount of \$450,000, and that the payment to Robert W. Barker, Attorney of Record and partner in the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker, of this sum out of the funds appropriated to pay the award herein for distribution by him to the participating attorneys in accordance with their respective interests therein will represent payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in this case.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated to pay the final judgment entered herein on March 8, 1971, in favor of the Lemhi Tribe, Represented by the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes, Fort Hall (24 Ind. Cl. Comm. 498), there shall be disbursed to Robert W. Barker, Attorney of Record, as payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in connection with the prosecution of this case, the sum


of \$450,000 for distribution by him to the participating attorneys in accordance with their respective interests therein.


