ORDER AMENDING FINDING OF FACT NO. 1

UPON CONSIDERATION of plaintiffs' motion filed July 9, 1971, to amend the Finding of Fact No. 1 to include the Red Cliff, St. Croix and Mole Lake Bands in the description of the bands which constituted the Lake Superior Chippewa Tribe, and the defendant's response thereto filed July 19, 1971, and it appearing that these three bands did constitute a part of the Lake Superior Chippewa Tribe, the Commission concludes that plaintiffs' motion should be granted.


