IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that:




2. The plaintiffs shall have and recover from defendant on their claims in Docket Nos. 30 and 48, the sum of \$521,796.00, subject to the terms set forth in the Stipulation filed herein on August 17, 1971, and adopted by the Commission by interlocutory order entered this day.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amended answer claiming offsets which was filed herein on August 2, 1971, shall be dismissed without prejudice.


