
FINAL AWARD

THE COMMISSION ENTERED on July 28, 1971, an interlocutory order upon findings of fact and opinion that day entered, ordering that plaintiff in this case recover from defendant the sum of \$5,754.96, less properly deductible offsets.

DEFENDANT HAS FILED with the Commission on September 27, 1971, an Amended Answer in which defendant makes no claims for offsets in this case, and in which defendant states it has no objections to the Commission making the interlocutory order of July 28, 1971, a final order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff shall have and recover from defendant the amount of \$5,754.96, this sum being in full satisfaction of all claims in Docket No. 261.




