
FINAL AWARD


THE COMMISSION ENTERED on November 13, 1969, an interlocutory order upon findings of fact and opinion that day entered, ordering that plaintiff in this case recover from defendant the sum of \$74,856.50 less properly deductible offsets.


DEFENDANT HAS FILED with the Commission on October 8, 1971, an Amended Answer in which defendant makes no claims for offsets in this case, and in which defendant states it has no objections to the Commission making the interlocutory order of November 13, 1969, a final order.


