
ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

HAVING CONSIDERED the petition of Jack Joseph, Esquire, Attorney of Record for the above named plaintiff, on behalf of himself and the contract attorneys herein for allowance of attorneys' fee and reimbursable expenses, filed on July 14, 1971, and in accord with the findings of the Commission filed herewith, the Commission concludes that the attorneys for plaintiff herein are entitled to an attorneys' fee in the amount of \$30,000.00, for services rendered in the prosecution of the plaintiffs' claim herein and that, further, the said attorneys are entitled to recover from the final award made herein the sum of \$5,490.81 as reimbursement of allowable expenses incurred in the prosecution of the claims presented in this docket and in Docket No. 334-A.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds to be appropriated to satisfy the final award in Docket No. 334-B to the Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma, on behalf of the Shawnee Nation, there shall be disbursed to Jack Joseph, Attorney of Record, as payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in the prosecution of this case, the sum of \$30,000.00, for distribution by him of the amount due each of the participating attorneys in accordance with their respective interest therein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that out of the funds to be appropriated as aforementioned there shall be disbursed to Jack Joseph, Attorney of Record, as payment in full for all claims for reimbursable expenses incurred in Docket No. 334-A and Docket No. 334-B, the sum of \$5,490.81, for distribution by him of the amounts due to persons entitled thereto.




