ORDER

WHEREAS on October 29, 1969, the United States stipulated with each plaintiff that it was liable for extinguishing the latter's Indian title to a particular area of land shown on a map accompanying the stipulation; the matter came on for hearing on June 18, 1970, to determine the date of taking and whether plaintiff Pueblo of Santo Domingo held aboriginal title to the area now embraced in the San Felipe Indian Reservation (a dispute having arisen between the United States and that plaintiff as to the applicability of their stipulation to such area); and the Commission is ready to rule on the questions before it but has been unable to complete its findings of fact due to irreconcilable land descriptions furnished by the parties, the discrepancies not having been settled by the parties as requested,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that each plaintiff listed above, before the close of business on Friday, March 3, 1972, serve upon the defendant and file with the Clerk of this Commission a corrected land description accurately setting forth the metes and bounds of its area of aboriginal occupancy as stipulated with the defendant on October 29, 1969, and depicted on the map accompanying that plaintiff's stipulation, and


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant, not later than the close of business on Friday, March 10, 1972, serve upon the plaintiffs and file in each docket listed above a statement to the effect that it either accepts the plaintiff's corrected land description in its entirety or contends that said description requires further correction specifying exactly what further correction it believes necessary.


In lieu of the foregoing, the parties are encouraged to confer and, not later than March 3, 1972, file agreed corrected land descriptions over the joint signatures of their respective attorneys.
