ORDER FIXING DATES OF ESTABLISHMENT  
 OF THE PYRAMID LAKE RESERVATION AND  
THE WALKER RIVER RESERVATION

On July 21, 1971, the plaintiffs moved for an interlocutory order as to the dates of establishment of the Pyramid Lake Reservation and Walker River Reservation. On August 26, 1971, the defendant filed its opposition to this motion, and on September 7, 1971, the plaintiffs replied to the defendant's opposition to the motion. On February 14, 1972, the defendant moved to withdraw its opposition to the plaintiffs' motion. However, the Commission having reached its determination in the matter and in view of this order, the defendant's motion is moot.

The Commission having taken the matter under advisement and now being fully informed in the premises, and for the reasons stated in the accompanying opinion, concludes:


That the Pyramid Lake Reservation and the Walker River Reservation were established on November 29, 1859.
