On February 1, 1971, the defendant filed an objection to the motion for rehearing. On February 8, 1971, the plaintiff in Docket No. 332-C filed in opposition to the motion. On March 2, 1971, plaintiffs in Docket No. 74 replied to the Docket No. 332-C plaintiff's opposition. On July 16, 1971, the Commission heard oral argument on the motion.


