
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS CLAIM


UPON CONSIDERATION of the defendant's motion, filed January 10, 1972, to dismiss this claim on the ground that it was extinguished by Section 4(a) or (b) or (c) of Public Law 92-203, the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of 1971 (85 Stat. 688, December 18, 1971), and the plaintiff not objecting thereto, this Commission concludes as a matter of law,

That Docket No. 187, being a claim for land and water based on aboriginal use and occupancy, is extinguished by Section 4(b) of the aforesaid Act. It is therefore


ORDERED that the motion to dismiss be granted, and Docket No. 187 is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
