That Docket No. 200, being a claim for land and water based on aboriginal use and occupancy, is extinguished by Section 4(b) of the aforesaid Act. It is therefore

ORDERED that the motion to dismiss be granted, and Docket No. 200 is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
