ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION of plaintiff's motion for a proper and more detailed accounting and plaintiff's exceptions 1 through 21 to defendant's accounting report, filed on August 28, 1970, defendant's response thereto, filed on October 13, 1970, plaintiff's motion for determination of issues of law, filed on July 23, 1971, and for the reasons set forth in the opinion this day entered herein,

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for a supplemental accounting (Exception No. 1) to reflect transactions up to and including the present date is denied without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff's motion be denied as to Exception Numbers 13, 15c, 15d, 15f, and 15g, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff's motion be, and the same is hereby granted with respect to the issues raised by Exception Numbers 2, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15a, 15b, 15e, 15h, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 21, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff's motion be granted in part as to Exception Number 20.

The Commission's rulings with respect to Exception Numbers 3, 5, 6, and 14 are held in abeyance.

IT IS ORDERED that the defendant furnish a supplementary accounting and such further evidence as is required by the Commission's rulings set forth in the opinion.






