
ORDER TO THE CLERK OF THE COMMISSION

For the reason that timely filed motions for rehearing of the Commission's decisions of March 1, 1972, 27 Ind. Cl. Comm. 49, and of March 8, 1972, 27 Ind. Cl. Comm. 72, were pending before the Commission, the Commission concludes that the notices of appeal filed herein by the Docket 74 plaintiffs on May 26, 1972, and by the defendant on June 1, 1972, are premature and cannot transfer jurisdiction of these dockets from the Commission to the Court of Claims, and that the record in these dockets should not be forwarded to the Court of Claims until said appeals become effective,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of the Commission neither certify the record in these dockets nor file the record in these dockets with the Clerk of the Court of Claims on or before June 26, 1972, as would ordinarily be required by Rules 172(b) and (c) of the Rules of the Court of Claims.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be sent by the Clerk of this Commission to the Clerk of the United States Court of Claims.


