FINAL AWARD

UPON JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT filed by the parties herein on May 25, 1972, pursuant to a Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment filed with said motion, the Commission has considered the evidence presented.

THE COMMISSION, having this day entered additional findings of fact, which are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the case is equitable and just to both parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with the stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment is hereby accepted, that the Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment is hereby granted and that the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$29,000.00) subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment.
