FINAL AWARD

UPON JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT filed by the parties herein on September 6, 1972, pursuant to a Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment previously filed herein as Exhibit C, the Commission considered the evidence presented, both oral and written, at a hearing called for that purpose on September 7, 1972.


THE COMMISSION, having entered herein findings of fact, which are hereby made part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the proposed settlement of the plaintiff's claim is fair and equitable to both parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with the stipulation.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Joint Motion for Entry of Final Judgment be, and the same is hereby granted; and that the plaintiff shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of four million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$4,750,000.00) subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this award shall in no way prevent the plaintiff from attempting to establish its right, in another docket, to an accounting for the period after June 30, 1951.
